



NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL OF WESTCHESTER / PLAYA 2010 ELECTION INFORMATION

On Sunday, April 11, 2010, the Neighborhood Council of Westchester/Playa will hold its board elections along with a number of other Neighborhood Councils on the Westside.

This is your opportunity to get involved, select those candidates who will serve on the Neighborhood Council and make a difference in your community.

Think of your Neighborhood Council as a group of local residents and representatives of local businesses, churches and schools, etc., working together to address important issues in our neighborhood.

As part of the city's Charter, Neighborhood Councils are an integral part of how local government operates, providing elected officials with a direct line to the community and how it stands on all issues.

The election for the Neighborhood Council of Westchester/Playa board of directors will be held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Sunday, April 11, 2010, at the CenterPointe Club at 6200 Playa Vista Drive in Playa Vista.

There will be ample parking under the building and plenty of street parking along Playa Vista Drive. ADA accessible parking is available from the underground lot beneath the building. Additionally, parking should be available at the library next door since the library is closed on Sundays.

The election is open to any member of the community who is at least 18 years of age on the date of the election and lives, works or owns property in Zip Codes 90293, 90045 or 90094. According to the election procedures approved by the City of Los Angeles, voters must "verify their stakeholder status by providing documentation acceptable to the City Clerk - Election Division. Stakeholder status may also be established by means of declaring a stake (or interest) in the neighborhood and providing documentation acceptable to the City Clerk - Election Division supporting that declaration. Factual Basis Stakeholders will also be required to provide a form of documentation to substantiate their factual basis claim."

It is suggested that those planning to vote in the election, bring with them to the polling location proof of stakeholder status, including driver's license, utility bill, property tax statement, pay stub, business tax registration certificate or other documentation that proves they live, work or own property in Zip Codes 90293, 90045 or 90094.

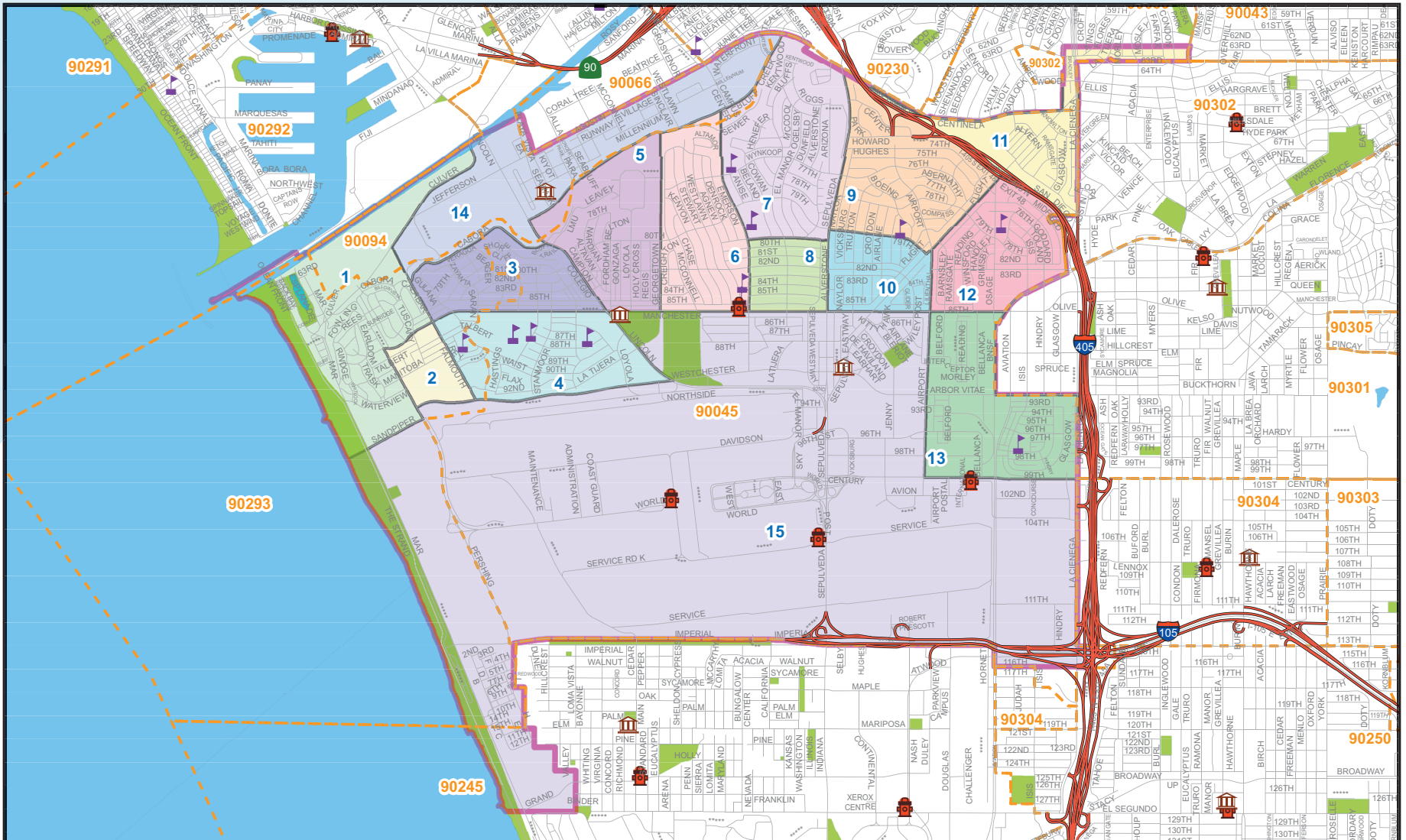
