**BACKGROUND:**

Airport Marina Counseling Service (AMCS) has been providing services to underprivileged youth and families in the NCWP Community through the At-Risk Kids Program AMCS aims to change the trajectory of he lives of youth to more positive outcomes, such as graduating school and building good relationships with others.

**DISCUSSION:**

The grant will benefit underprivileged children and families that have little or no access to mental health. These services come at no charge. According to AMCS, 70-80% of program participants benefit from the therapy, as measured by improved relationships with families, better grades and attendance in school, and demonstrating positive behavior as measured by reduction in fighting, truancy and academic failure.
