
Mobility & Safety Improvements are Coming to Manchester Boulevard!

The City of Los Angeles is making improvements to Manchester Boulevard in Westchester. The project features street repaving, fresh pavement markings, and upgrades to sections of the existing bike lane to create a safer and smoother ride for everyone and improve access to commercial hubs along Manchester.



What's Changing?

- New pavement on Manchester from Sepulveda Blvd to Osage Ave
- Upgraded protected bike lane from Truxton Ave to Osage Ave to improve safety and prevent collisions
- Removal of underutilized parking spaces east of Truxton Ave

What's Not Changing?

- Two existing travel lanes will be maintained throughout the project corridor
- All parking for businesses will be retained between Sepulveda and Truxton
- Existing striped bike lane will remain the same between Sepulveda and Truxton
