RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation that for the fifth consecutive year, the Neighborhood Council of Westchester/Playa **sponsor a booth at the expo component of the 2nd Annual Rock, Roll & Run** on March 9, 2019 to: 1) Outreach to the local community informing them about the Neighborhood Council of Westchester/Playa; 2) Support local Westchester/Playa schools through booth sponsorship; 3) Share information about our local schools by disseminating the Westchester/Playa del Rey/Playa Vista Schools; and 4) Raise awareness of the upcoming NCWP Election.

BACKGROUND:

The 2⁻⁻ Annual Rock, Roll, & Run for Education (the race that replaced the Annual Race for Success is a widely successfully 5K race (with 1K children's walk) and expo held at Loyola Marymount University.
