However, if you loss your section 509(a)(2) status, a grantor or contributor may not rely on this determination if he or she was in part responsible for, or was awars of, the act or failure to act, or the substantial or material change on the part of the organization that resulted in your loss of such status, or if he or she acquired knowledge that the Internal Revenue Service had given notice that you would no longer be classified as a section 509(a)(2) organization.
