The event, held adjacent to Bill Rosendahl Del Rey Park, was a great opportunity to meet our community's first responders, community organizations and businesses. The event included food, music, giveaways and fun for all.

National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make our neighborhoods safer, more caring places to live. National Night Out enhances the relationship between neighbors and law enforcement while bringing back a true sense of community. Furthermore, it provides a great opportunity to bring police and neighbors together under positive circumstances.

### CIRCLE is coming to your community

CIRCLE is a 24/7 unarmed response program that deploys trained teams to address low risk 9-1-1 and 877-ASK-LAPD calls related to unhoused individuals.

#### 24/7 Response

CIRCLE responds to incidents involving unhoused individuals that are not violent, criminal, or medically urgent.

Examples include well-being checks, lack of clothing, noise disturbances, person on a substance, and loitering.

On August 25, CIRCLE will expand its current Venice and Del Rey service area to also cover Oakwood, Mar Vista, Palms, Playa Vista, Playa Del Rey, Westchester, and Manchester Square.
