

5.5.26 - NC Report

Public Safety

- Vista Del Mar
 - Introduced our motion today to transfer funding to DOT for traffic safety enhancements along Vista Del Mar
 - Will include a median K rail barrier and speed humps
 - Vista Del Mar also receiving an Automated Speed Enforcement Camera as part of a citywide pilot program (La Tijera Blvd is also on this list)
- Pershing Dr
 - We held our Town Hall, conducted a community survey, and recently conducted a pilot configuration of a single lane closure on southbound Pershing Dr to assess potential impacts
 - We are continuing to improve potential pathways forward that improve safety for all road users
- LAPD Beach Detail
 - Pacific Division receiving additional officers for Summer Beach Deployment, including 25 additional Officers and 2 Sergeants.
 - 2 units to be deployed at Dockweiler each day and night. All of them will receive special training related to bonfire enforcement.

Homelessness & Housing

- 405 encampment (from La Cienega to La Tijera)
 - Working with Caltrans and the County on an encampment resolution, including offers of interim housing for each individual
 - Our teams are conducting outreach over the next couple of weeks with a target date of May 27, 2026 for final encampment resolution.
- 41.18s
 - Approved & awaiting signage installation
 - Bristol Farms area
 - Alley behind Yum Yum Donuts/Roberts Market (5700-5900 Manchester Ave)
 - Additional areas pending public safety findings
 - Airport Blvd south of Manchester Ave (near LADWP power box)
 - Pool Lot Task Force
 - We coordinated an additional “Pool Lot Task Force” with Park Rangers, LAPD, and DOT to address vehicles parked illegally in the pool parking lot at Westchester Park

Community Improvements

- Pershing Dr from Imperial Hwy to Westchester Pkwy
 - Worked with LAWA and the Office of Major Events to have this street segment added to the resurfacing list for FY26/27
- Jefferson Blvd Bike Lane progress
 - Bike lane has been installed!
 - We are working with the Dept of Cultural Affairs to install a mural reflecting the ecological diversity of the Ballona Wetlands
- Continuing median weed abatement along Manchester Ave
- Street Services has been laying fresh coats of slurry seal on segments throughout Westport Heights and Osage.
- Our office has requested street sweeping for requested streets, including Vicksburg Ave, Osage Ave, and La Tijera Blvd. (We can request one-time street sweeping if anyone wants to reach out to me)
